

(Match report prepared by Jeff Swartz)

The 1st 2021 100-Yard Airgun Benchrest match at Fairfield Sportsmen's Association was held on Sunday, April 18th. There were eleven competitors in attendance and all participated in the ASA 3-Card Challenge (therefore all scoring was done with a .35 caliber plug, the maximum caliber allowed by ASA rules). We again used the

combined total of all 3 cards to determine the top 3 places. The most common choice of caliber was .30 cal, and was used by 6 of the 11 participants. Two used a .25 cal, two shot a .22 cal, and one used a .35 cal. The day started with very still air and little, if any, wind. As the temperature rose, the wind picked up significantly. Several otherwise really good cards were ruined by only 2 or 3 bulls shot during wind shifts. I saw many new faces on the line and we hope to see them all back for all 4 of our matches this year. In the end, Chuck Richmond schooled us all with a top score of 657 powered by a dominating 227 in his second round. Filling out the top 3 were Ryan Spanagel in second (641) and Jeff Swartz in third (632). Chuck, Ryan and Donnie Reed had the top 3 big bore scores of the day, while Chris Oldfield swept the top 3 small bore scores.
