



(Match report prepared by Jeff Swartz)

The 2nd 100-Yard Airgun Benchrest match of 2022 was held at Fairfield Sportsmen's Association on Saturday, May 28.

Based on the early weather, our impression was it was going to be a high scoring day. The temperature was pleasant and there were occasional mild steady breezes, but for the most part the wind flags placed in the field barely moved for long periods of time. We did see several scores in the 220's in the first round, including the highest single card of the day, a 229 4X shot by Troy Hammer. Then, the tricky winds that this range is known for reared up caused some problems. We saw a light but steady right to left breeze, but a completely unpredictable wind occasionally pushing shots down (really far down). We had several shoot very good cards with mostly 8, 9 and 10's that were blown up with an odd 4 and 5.

We had 11 shooters with 10 shooting .30 caliber and one shooting a .25. We've seen much improvement among our participants. 1st place to 8th place was only separated by 24 points (an average of 8 points per card). That's a really competitive field. When the dust settled, Jeff Swartz took the top spot with a 672 11X, second was Tim Swan with a 664 13X (most X's of the day) and in third was Troy Hammer with a 661 9X. Troy had an unusual entry among a sea of FX Impacts and Crowns. He was shooting (for the first time) a custom tuned double-bottle Kral Bighorn that he only put a scope on the night before. Pretty impressive stuff.

We had some extra time, so we did a 4th "Fun Card" with a prize to be awarded to whomever improved the most from the highest of their 3 scores. But as it turns out, no one improved so we went with who was below but closest to their high

score. Rob Moore shot the 4th card only 2 points below his high and walked away with a \$50 gift certificate to Baker Airguns.
