



(4/10/22 Match report prepared by Jeff Swartz)

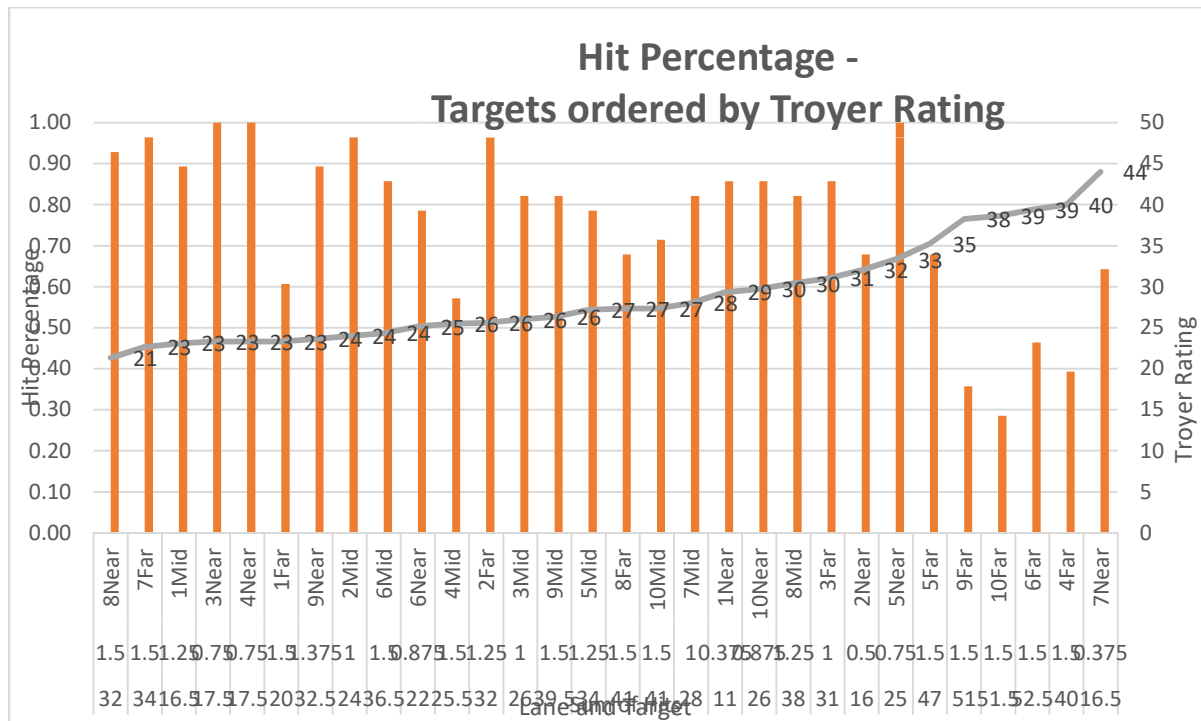
The first Airgun Field Target Match of 2022 at FSA is in the books. 14 shooters representing 4 different classes showed up and were rewarded with the nicest, bright and sunny day of the year so far. Many shed layers of clothing as the day went on and a couple ended the match in t-shirts. Personally I think I got a little too much sun this early in the year. The course was a very mild 28.96 Troyer with only 6 lanes over 40 yards. The standing lane was a pushover, with a 75% hit rate for the field. The kneeling hit rate was slightly under 50%, mostly due to the longer target being at 40 yards. We introduced 5 new faceplates bolted to rat targets to add more variety. The fancy paint jobs that drew many compliments may have been a detriment to the shooters. There were a few breezes that kicked up from left to right, but the leaves and grass hadn't grown in enough to easily read the winds downrange. The paint scheme made a couple of long ones nearly impossible to see hits at 16X. Upon inspection during cleanup, nearly all misses on those faceplates (and there were a lot) were right of the KZ. We had a couple of cold lines to check targets and clean some led from one of the 3/8 KZ. One questionable target was given as hits to the entire field, so some may see a higher score below than what was turned in. In the Hunter PCP class that included 10 of the 14 shooters, Jeff Swartz and Dale Prulheire both scored 54 which was the match high score. The shooters decided to flip a coin and Dale came out on top with Jeff in second. Ryan Spanagel turned in a 51 for 3rd place. In hunter piston, the lone shooter, Eric Jones shot an impressive 47. We had two shooting Open PCP and Keith Walters shot a 52 for first and Ted Andro came in second with a 44. WFTF PCP also had a single shooter, Stan Kaloyanov, who shot a 40. We had a couple first timers who turned in very respectable scores in the 40's. It was a very nice start for 2022 FT season.
