



(5/15/22 Match report prepared by Jeff Swartz)

FSA's second Airgun Field Target Match of 2022 was held on Sunday May 15th, 2022. 11 shooters participated with 8 in Hunter PCP class and one each in Hunter Piston, Unlimited PCP, and WFTF PCP. We had beautiful warm sunny weather. A few mentioned seeing a few small wind pushes on the farthest targets, but for the most part the conditions were very calm and mild. The Troyer rating of the course was 30.93T with 9 lanes over 40 yards. The forced position lanes were on the difficult side with all 4 between 24 and 32 yards, but with either 1 3/8 or 1 1/2 kill zones. The course followed a theme of "back to back". We had back to back 3/8 targets, back to back standing and kneeling lanes, and back to back 55 yard targets.

In the Hunter PCP class Jeff Swartz came out on top with a 53, one shot behind with a 52 was Justin Roberts and Ryan Spanagel took third with a 45. Ryan was tied with Dale Prulheire so we went to the total of both kneeling and standing lanes to break the tie with Ryan scoring one more than Dale. Chris Oldfield was our lone WFTF PCP participant, shooting a 47. In hunter piston, Nolan Caudill shot a solid 34 with a new HW97 he's only had for less than a month. The piston guys better look out for him in coming matches. Jim Miller shot a 40 in the Unlimited PCP class that seems to be attracting more of a following.
