The last Field Target match of 2022 at FSA is complete. The match was held Sunday, October 9. It was only fitting that as we approach Halloween, that we would show up to shoot the match and have an eerie mist and fog rising up and rolling across the sight-in range. The day started with some the lowest temperatures we've seen in a while;


just over 40 degrees at 9AM. Almost everyone arrived bundled up with jackets and warm clothes. As the day progressed, the temps kept building and the sun came out. Many started shedding layers as the lanes with shooting positions in the sun almost became too warm.

The course was set up with a 32.7 Troyer rating. The forced position lanes were some of the easiest we've had all year, and the course, while not very long, had many challenging targets. Brown targets set in and among the leaves and plants were hard to make out with the naked eye. A couple of black targets tucked into some very dark places made everyone wish they had a lighted reticle as crosshairs seemed to all but disappear when addressing these targets.

We had 11 total shooters (8 in Hunter PCP and 1 each in Hunter Piston, WFTF Piston, and Open Piston). In Hunter PCP, Mike Gann ran away with from the pack with a match high 56. Jeff Little took 2nd with a 51 and Jeff Swartz and Dave Hitchcock tied with a 50. Dave won the ensuing coin flip to finish 3^{rd.} In WFTF Piston Jeff Paddock shot a 46 and in Open Piston Tyler Patner shot a 44, securing a 1st for both. We had a new shooter from Kentucky, Greg Baker, join us. While he's a field target rookie, you can tell he did his homework on equipment and rig set-up. Greg shot a phenomenal first time 44 and he even stuck around to help with a partial tear down of the course. We look forward to seeing Greg become a regular at our matches next year. I also have to recognize Ryan Spanagel. He was not going to be available on Saturday to help set up or Sunday to shoot the match. But, he took a half day off on Friday and set up the entire course himself. I was going to help, but he was finished before I was even able to leave work. He also showed up Sunday morning to help before he had to leave to attend to family obligations. His extra hard work allowed us all to enjoy a nice FT match.
