



(Match report prepared by Jeff Swartz)

The fourth 100-yard benchrest match of 2023 was held at Fairfield Sportsmen's Association on Saturday, July 15.

It wasn't a great start to a match, but it turned out to be a record-breaking day. Those that showed up around 9:00 AM were greeted with an absolute downpour. The rain came down in buckets for quite a while. Luckily, Ryan had already hung practice targets, so everyone was able to get warmed up for the match while it rained. We could see a break in the storm coming on the weather radar, so everyone signed in and targets were prepped. The break in the rain looked like it would only hold for an hour or two, so we started the match about a half hour early as soon as the rain let up. We also ran all three cards consecutively without scoring in between to try to get all 3 in before the next wave of storms. And we were successful! The rain may have played a role in our record-breaking day. The lull between storms seemed to bring with it cooler temperatures and very calm breezes as opposed to the heat induced winds that this course is known for.

After scoring the first round of cards, Robert Steele jumped into the lead with a 237 5X that for a brief moment would be a record high. Robert shot another great score in the second round, a 232 3X. That makes him only the second shooter to have 2 cards of 230 or greater in a 3-card match. The only other shooter to accomplish that feat, Jeff Swartz, lit the second round on fire with a 240 10X card that would become the highest score we've ever seen at FSA. That phenomenal score cut Robert's lead to just 1 point. The favorable conditions started to deteriorate in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final round and Jeff shot a 225 4X that locked up 1<sup>st</sup> place with a 693 16X total. Robert posted a 218 0X putting him in 2<sup>nd</sup> place with 687 8X. Jeff's 693 16X score also set a record for the all-time highest 3-card series at FSA. Chris Oldfield, who just picked up his new FX Crown from Baker

Airguns the week before the match, finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> place with a 676 9X total and also posted a 230 card.

The rain that came down while we were scoring the first match began to ease, so we prepped for a second 3-card match. We had one group of 5 shooters participating in our .22 caliber showdown. A Hawke hat and lens pens were waiting for the top 2 scorers. Ryan Spanagel took the top spot with a 642 5X and Brandon Michaud finished second with 624 3X. Four others enjoyed an open caliber shoot with Ritchy Tuazon finishing with the high score of 674 1X followed closely by Tom Cox with a 672 11X.

After the first match, we did a no cost raffle for our loyal FSA benchrest shooters. Ritchy Tuazon's ticket was drawn first and he selected the Hawke Nature Trek monocular and every other person in attendance received either a Hawke hat, lens pen, or drink cozie. Thank you, Hawke Optics, for your generosity.
