



(Match report prepared by Jeff Swartz)

Saturday, August 19 was another great day for 100-yard benchrest at Fairfield Sportsmen's Association. As the gates opened early in the morning, there was a thick fog blanketing the range. The weather was warm, but not hot, and the fog gradually burned off. Winds varied from nearly non-existent to 1-3 mph. Even with the mild winds, they still proved to be shifty and could wreck a bull or two if you weren't paying attention. But overall, the conditions were definitely primed for a high scoring day, and we would not be disappointed.

Nine individuals showed up to prove they were ready for the Pyramyd Air Cup that was set to start in only 6 days. To help with the preparation for that big event, we decided to run 2 matches of 3 cards each and we encouraged everyone to shoot what they planned on using at PAC. In the first of the 2 matches, we had 4 shooters score 230 or better at least once in the first 2 cards. Tom Cox shot not one but two 230+ cards in the first two rounds (233 and 231), making him only the third person ever to realize that accomplishment. Those two great cards and another solid one in the third round carried him to 1<sup>st</sup> place. Tom's 692 10X performance also gave him the second highest 3-card score we've recorded. Great shooting Tom! Jeff Swartz held onto 2<sup>nd</sup> place thanks to a match high 236 7X and he finished with 689 15X. Robert Steele followed in 3<sup>rd</sup> place, putting up a 684 12X.

Seven of the nine participants decided to stick around for the second match. This one proved to be even more competitive. We had 3 people shoot 230+ cards with Robert Steele also shooting two 230+ cards (his second time achieving that feat). After two cards the scores were impossibly tight. The top 3 after 2 cards was Robert Steele with 462, Chris Oldfield with 461 and Jeff Swartz with 460. Robert's third card dropped off a bit with a still solid 225, putting him in 3<sup>rd</sup> with

687 16x. Jeff shot a 229 that made up the one-point difference with Chris as he shot a 228. With the top 2 tied at 689 we had to go to the x-count for the tie breaker. Jeff emerged in 1<sup>st</sup> with 689 14X and Chris finished second with 689 11X.
