



(7/30/23 Match report prepared by Jeff Swartz)

FSA's fourth field target match of 2023 is a wrap. The match was held Sunday, July 30. For the first time in a long time, inclement weather never entered the picture. Stormy weather passed through early Saturday, and in its wake we received pleasant sunny skies and a temperature that never got past 85 or so. Not that it wasn't hot for the lanes with shooting positions in the sun, but overall, it was a very nice day with an occasional breeze here and there.

The course was set up at a moderately difficult 32.66T. There were 12 targets over 40 yards and the average distance was just under 36 yards. Only 3 classes were contested at this match. In hunter piston we saw one of the more incredible scores of the match. Dan Putz put away first place with a 54 that was only bested by one other shooter at the match out of the 12 attendees (10 of which were shooting PCPs). Absolutely incredible shooting Dan! In WFTF PCP we had not one, but two shooters using the new Air Arms XTi50, but both were topped by Lucas Marusiak who shot a 52 with his Thomas. In our most contested class of Hunter PCP, Ryan Spanagel shot 57, his best score ever, to top the 7 other participants. Jeff Swartz following in second place with a 54 and Doug Cunningham took third with 51. All 3 shooters who topped their classes were awarded hats courtesy of Hawke Optics. Don't forget that Pyramyd Air and Baker Airguns are also sponsors and keep them in mind when you need to add to your Airgun collection or feed your need for lead.
